- Pesticide exposure in school-age children
- Groundwater quality and human health
- Human health impacts of area-wide air emissions like ozone

Bring research ideas you want feedback on from community stakeholders and scientists. Pitch ideas on environmental health research to experienced environmental health scientists, and hear from our stakeholder advisory committee about how your project could be useful to their communities. Priority is given to researchers pitching EHSC-funded pilot projects.
